### 1) Heart of Europe

2) People, religion & language

人口は 1,000 万、首都 Prague で 150 万、Bohemia,Moravia,Silesia 地方に分かれ、Czech81.2%、Moravian13.2%、Silesian 0.4%,Slovak 3.1%(大半は学生)、Roma 0.3% の民族構成です。 宗教は Atheist が何と 40%以上(2001 年のデータでは

60%)、Roman Catholic40%、説明ではさらっと通ってしまいましたが、この点再確認してみたいですね。言語は Czech95%です。

### 3) Food

Czech cuisine is marked by a strong emphasis on meat dishes. Pork is quite common, and beef and chicken are also popular. Knedlíky (boiled and sliced dumplings) are one of the mainstays of Czech cuisine and are quite often served with meals. Beer in the Czech Republic has a long and important history. Most towns had at least one brewery, the most famous brewing cities in Bohemia were Budweis, Plzeň and had breweries in the 13th century. Hops have been grown in the region for a long time, and were used in beer making



and exported from here since the twelfth century. The Czech Republic has the highest beer consumption per capita in the world.

The most famous Czech beer brands are Pilsner Urquell and Budweiser Budvar. The term "Budweiser" is also regarded as an appellation in the Czech Republic because it is the adjective taken from the German name for Budweis. It was a German immigrant to the United States who coined the term for his beer when he established the Budweiser brewery.

#### 5) Tradition

Christmas dinner wouldn't be the same without Carp and potato salad. Another integral part of the Czech Christmas celebrations are Christmas cookies. Some of the ever-presents on Czech Christmas tables are honey gingerbread (medové perníčky) decorated with icing, vanilla rolls, Linz pastry and Christmas loaf with raisins. Baked sweet dishes at Easter reflect Christian symbols: Lamb shaped sponge cake are baked in special moulds and other types of cakes and doughnuts are also prepared.

Around Easter time in Prague and the Czech Republic, it is possible to find hand-painted Easter eggs for sale. Easter eggs vary in the ways they have been decorated and the colors and designs used. Some Easter egg designs are regional designs.

## 6) Souvenirs

### Czech Puppet and Marionette

Czech Republic has a long history of puppets, and therefore marionettes or puppets made in the Czech Republic are wonderful Czech souvenirs. It is possible to find toy puppets and marionettes in Prague as well as puppets and marionettes that are expertly crafted, delicately detailed, and priced to reflect their quality.

The garnet is the Czech national gem, and therefore a perfect souvenir of your Czech adventure. While artificial garnets abound, at reputable shops it's possible to find reasonably-priced and good-quality garnets in gold, gold-plated silver, or other settings.
